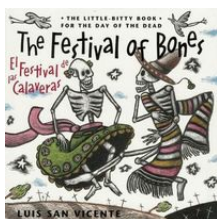


FESTIVAL OF THE BONES / EL FESTIVAL DE LAS CALAVERAS
