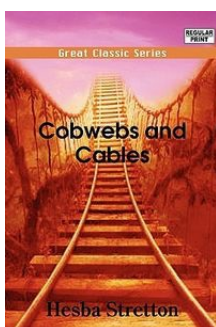


COBWEBS AND CABLES
