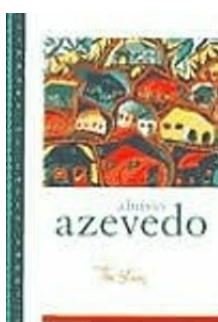


# THE SLUM
