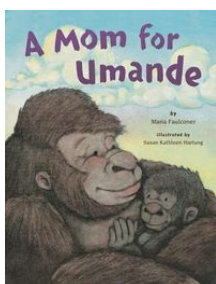


A MOM FOR UMANDE
