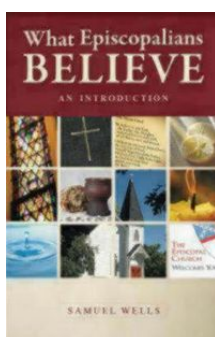


# WHAT EPISCOPALIANS BELIEVE: AN INTRODUCTION
